<b>C.S_03</b>	Physical & Motor Development in Childhood - Milestones, variations, factors influencing growth.
<b>C.S_04</b>	Cognitive Development in Early & Middle Childhood - Attention, memory, problem-solving, learning processes.
<b>C.S_05</b>	Emotional Development & Emotion Regulation - How children understand and express feelings.
<b>C.S_06</b>	Social Development: Attachment & Relationships - Parent–child bonding, peer interactions
<b>C.S_07</b>	Language Development in Children - Vocabulary, grammar, bilingualism, delays.
<b>C.S_08</b>	Personality & Temperament in Childhood - Easy, difficult, slow-to-warm-up temperaments.
<b>C.S_09</b>	Play & its Role in Development - Types of play, symbolic play, learning through play.
<b>C.S_10</b>	Behavioural Issues in Childhood - Defiance, tantrums, attention difficulties—understanding, not diagnosing.
<b>C.S_11</b>	Family & Parenting Influences on Child Behaviour - Parenting styles, routines, communication.
<b>C.S_12</b>	Ethical & Cultural Issues in Working with Children - Consent, assent, boundaries, cultural norms.

<b>O.S_15</b>	Autism Spectrum – Childhood Indicators - Communication, routines, social challenges.
<b>O.S_16</b>	ADHD & Attention-Related Difficulties - Hyperactivity, impulsivity, attention lapses.
<b>O.S_17</b>	Emotional Problems in Children - Anxiety, fears, school refusal.
<b>O.S_18</b>	Aggression & Anger in Childhood - Causes, expression, regulation basics.
<b>O.S_19</b>	Bullying: Roles & Dynamics - Victim, bully, bystander psychology.
<b>O.S_20</b>	Cognitive Errors & Thinking Patterns in Children - Egocentrism, magical thinking, black-and-white thinking.
<b>O.S_21</b>	Gender Development & Social Expectations - Identity, roles, stereotypes.
<b>O.S_22</b>	Social Skills & Peer Relationships - Friendship development, isolation, shyness.
<b>O.S_23</b>	Grief & Loss in Children - How children understand death and separation.

<b>O.S_25</b>	Childhood Stress & Coping Skills - School pressure, family conflict, transitions.
<b>O.S_26</b>	Classroom Behaviour & Learning Environment Factors - Teacher influence, seating, routines.
<b>O.S_27</b>	Observing Children: Techniques for Students - Naturalistic observation, anecdotal records, MSE basics (child-friendly).
<b>O.S_28</b>	Emotional Needs of Gifted Children - Asynchrony, sensitivity, perfectionism.
<b>O.S_29</b>	Single-Parent, Divorced & Blended Families - Adjustment, emotional impact.
<b>O.S_30</b>	Abuse & Neglect – Psychological Indicators - Red flags, behavioural clues, safety steps (no counselling).
<b>O.S_31</b>	Early Adolescence – Transition Challenges - Body image, identity, relationships.
<b>O.S_32</b>	Nutrition, Sleep & Behaviour in Children - Cognitive–emotional effects of lifestyle
<b>O.S_33</b>	Child Psychology in Indian Context - Cultural norms, academic pressure, family structures.
<b>O.S_34</b>	Case Conference – Testing the learner with various cases / vignettes on learnt disorders
